

NZDG Major Tour Events 25/26 Specification

NZDG North Island Championships

- Dates not earlier than Labour weekend in October 2025
- Preference of PDGA B Tier or higher (high level C tier exhibiting most B tier requirements may also be considered by Negotiation)
- Minimum player capacity of 150.
- Shorter tees of appropriate length provided for some Am Divs and Juniors
- All Baskets and tees of uniform standard and meeting PDGA International standard requirements for tier sought.
- Suitable range of accommodation options nearby
- Focus on NZ Players and player entry affordability

NZDG South Island Championships

- Dates not earlier than Labour weekend in October 2025
- Minimum PDGA B Tier or higher
- Minimum player capacity of 170, (200 preferred)
- Shorter tees of appropriate length provided for some Am Divs and Juniors
- All Baskets and tees of uniform standard and meeting PDGA International standard requirements for tier sought.
- Suitable range of accommodation options nearby
- Focus on NZ Players and player entry affordability

NZDG National Championships

- Dates not earlier than 1st February 2026
- Minimum of 1 practice and 3 playing days (cut may be entertained for events with 4 playing days only).
- Tee times used, minimum capacity of 180 players, 250 preferred
- Course(s) to be 18 holes
- Multiple layouts in use relevant to division skill levels. (suggest alt pars for Ma2/Fa1 and combo of alt pars and shortened tees for juniors and Ma3/Fa2)
- All Baskets and tees of uniform standard and meeting PDGA International standard requirements for tier sought.
- Suitable range of travel and accommodation options nearby
- Focus of event **MUST** be on NZ Player achievement, and player entry affordability

Additional Desirable Outcomes to NZDG - All Majors

- Run by/in partnership with an NZDG affiliated club, for the benefit of a club
- Event results in the installation, refit, or Improvement of a permanent, publicly accessible course
- Creation/procurement of club assets that can be reused and redeployed for future events. (line markers, portables, tee pads etc)
- Applicant has run an event on the 2024/2025 NZDG Tour
